




### EXTRAORDINARY GIVE



### Sweet Potato Quesadillas

*SWS Cooking Club 11.11.16*

1/2 c finely chopped onions	2 garlic cloves, minced
3 tbsp. vegetable oil	2 tsp ground cumin
4 c peeled, grated sweet potatoes	1 tsp turmeric
1-2 pinches cayenne pepper or chili powder	
Salt & pepper to taste	8 (8 inch) flour tortillas
1 c shredded sharp cheddar cheese	Salsa & sour cream, for serving

Heat vegetable oil in a large, non-stick skillet. Saute' onions and garlic until onions are transparent. Add sweet potatoes and spices. Cover and cook for 10 min., stirring frequently to prevent sticking. And when tender remove from heat. Spread the sweet potato mixture evenly onto the tortillas; sprinkle each with 2 tbsp. cheese. Fold tortilla in half. Wipe out the skillet, add a small amount of oil and heat over med. Cook quesadillas on each side for 2-3 min.
